# **Market Profile**

- 48.4 million Is the estimated Hispanic population of the United States as of July 1, 2014, the nation's largest ethnic or race minority.
- 3.1% was the percentage increase in the Hispanic population between July 1, 2008, and July 1, 2009.
- 132.8 million is the projected Hispanic population of the United States on July 1, 2050. According to this projection, Hispanics will constitute 30% of the nation's population by that date.
- As of 2009 the U.S. Hispanic population is 2nd Ranking in the world; only Mexico with111 million had a larger Hispanic population than the United States' 48.4 million.
- 25.8 years is the Median age of the Hispanic population in 2009. This compared with 36.8 years for the population as a whole.
- 4.9 million is the Hispanic population of Los Angeles County, Calif., in 2009 the largest of any county in the nation.
- \$345.2 billion in Receipts were generated by Hispanic-owned businesses in 2007, up 55.5 percent from 2002.
- 76% of Hispanics of age 5 and older speak Spanish at home.


# The U.S. Hispanic Population Grew 4 times faster than the Total Population


Between 2000 and 2010, the U.S. Hispanic Population grew by 43% growing from 20.6 million in 2000 to 31.8 million in 2010.



Please ensure electronic files submitted meet the following requirements:

- Applications accepted: MAC or PC Platforms; Quark XPress 7 or earlier; Adobe Photoshop; Adobe InDesign, Adobe Illustrator, Adobe PDF (high resolution) Cs5 or earlier; Freehand, Coreldraw X6 or earlier.
- All fonts need to be included and placed in a separate folder; include both screen and printer fonts. Do not stylize fonts in the layout applications.
- All images used need to be included and placed in a separate folder. Do not embed images.
- All graphics must be in TIFF or EPS format. All photos should be at least 300 DPI. All bitmapped graphics (line art) should be at least 600 DPI. No RGB or JPEG compressed images. No LZW compression.
- All colors should be assigned a CMYK value unless spot colors are being used for output.
- Please do not include crop or registration marks in the file
