

Loose Insert/Bound & Stitched in Insert Specifications

The following specification applies to loose inserts which are inserted by machine into A4 magazines.

190mm wide x 225mm deep Maximum size

Minimum size 105mm wide x 148mm deep

Minimum weight of paper Single leaf: 90gsm

> Four pages: 80gsm Eight pages: 65gsm

NOTE: Folded inserts must have a closed edge if they are to be machine fed, if unsure please supply a sample.

Presentation of Inserts:

For efficient production at the bindery, inserts should conform as follows:-

- Pallets should be wrapped to provide stability and weather protection of inserts.
- Labels must state publication name, month and quantity of inserts / box or pallet.
- Inserts should be stacked in large bundle quantities, not less than 50 per turn.
- Tip-on's / CD's should be boxed, uniformly oriented, and have dividers between layers.
- Inserts in cartons must be unbanded and not turned within the box.
- Inserts must be packed flat with tight folds, no distortions or any curled edges.
- An additional handling charge may be applied if inserts have to be repacked to make them acceptable for production.

Inserts that do not conform to the above specifications may be rejected if not suitable for mechanical insertion.
